MR. JIM THOMAS GOES TO WASHINGTON

On June 6th, D Day, James Thomas, retired postmaster of the Wilmore Post office and a veteran of WW II, along with two other men from Jessamine County, W. T. Brumfeild and George Pope plus 81 other WW II vets from Kentucky & Indiana met at the Louisville, Kentucky airport for a trip to visit the WW II Memorial and other memorials in Washington, DC. They flew out of Louisville at about 7:00 in the morning and landed in Baltimore, MD at 8:20 am. From there they were put on tour buses and taken to the WW II Memorial, the Korean Memorial & the Marine Corp Memorial.

The trip was arranged by Honor Flight, Inc. In talking to Mr. Earl Morris, the founder of Honor Flight, he said that by the end of 2009 he hoped to have taken 42,000 WW II vets to see the Memorial. Mr. Thomas stated that he thought that he would never get to see it much less visit it. He said that it was absolutely fantastic. By the end of the day Mr. Thomas and the man that took such good care of him all day were both tired. He was very happy to have shared the experience with other veterans by visiting the memorials that honor our US military. The Comprehensive Plan Update Committee will hold two meetings the second week of July. If you are interested in the planning future of Jessamine County a meeting will be held in Wilmore, Tuesday, July 7th at 6 p.m. in the Community Center at Wesley Village. Another meeting will be held in Nicholasville, Wednesday, July 8th at 6 p.m. at the Jessamine County Public Library. The committee is listening to final recommendations from the public in order to finalize the county future land use map for the entire county.

Land use maps of the comprehensive plans indicate designated areas for specific types of development. This reference is used by the Planning Commissions when discussing or approving areas for business, residential development or annexation. The maps have a 20-year outlook based on current projections and trends in the county. The Plan is updated every 5 years.
